


Wildfire Insights

La Niña events are 2.5 times more likely than El Niño events to cause billion-dollar wildfire losses.



of wildfires larger than **100 acres** from 2000 to 2020 were found to be **started by humans**.

112222 30% of us POPULATION

lives in the Wildland Urban Interface (WUI), where population borders forests and wildlands, even though it's only **9.4% of land area**. 96 40 96 days had the highest wildfire preparedness in 2024, compared to an average of 40 days in a typical year.
