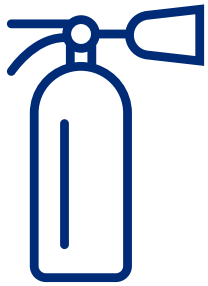
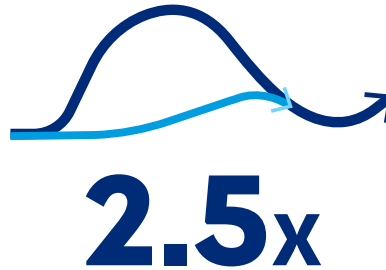


Wildfire Insights

La Niña events are 2.5 times more likely than El Niño events to cause **billion-dollar wildfire losses**.

lives in the Wildland Urban Interface (WUI), where population borders forests and wildlands, even though it's only **9.4% of land area**.



67.7%

of wildfires larger than **100 acres** from 2000 to 2020 were found to be **started by humans**.
